H. T. Ford Graduate Servant Leadership Award

The H.T. Ford Graduate Servant Leadership Award is presented to a Columbus State University College of Education and Health Professions graduate student who has best exemplified the spirit of excellence in the following categories:

- Demonstrated Excellence in the Area of Leadership
- Demonstrated Excellence in the Area of Service
- Demonstrated Excellence in the Area of Academic Performance (Include GPA)
- Demonstrated Excellence in Commitment to the Development of Self and Others

Note: nominations will be solicited at date to be determined.

The Dean will submit one nomination to the University Graduate Council. The college documents should include:

- A cover letter submitted by the Dean to include a statement about the nominee's accomplishments in teaching and service relevant to the award
- Letter of endorsement by the Dean and a maximum of 3 others who are knowledgeable about the graduate faculty nominee's achievement.

Note: Each department selects 1 nominee and the college award winner will be the submitted to the University Graduate Council.
