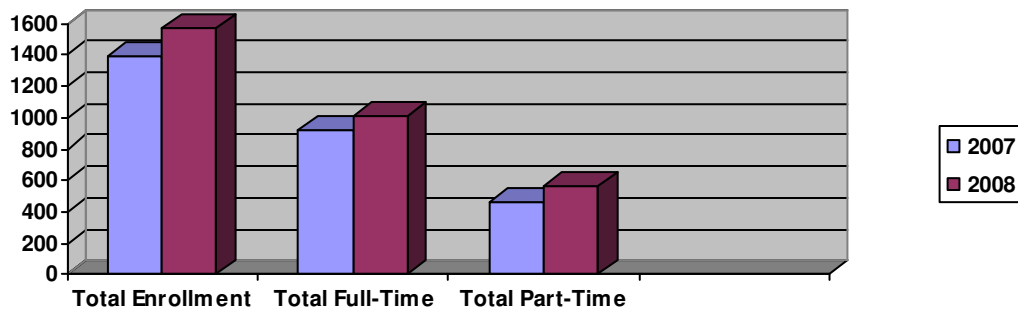

2008 Summary of Enrollment Totals for Full-Time and Part-Time Status

The total enrollment (full-time and part-time students) for undergraduate and graduate programs is 1,567 students. The undergraduate program accounts for 67.6% of the College of Education's total enrollment.

2008 Summary of Full-Time Undergraduate and Graduate Students by Gender

The total enrollment for full-time students in the undergraduate and graduate programs is 1006. The *undergraduate* program accounts for 77.8% of the College of Education's total full-time enrollment. In addition, the female population accounts for 74.7% of the undergraduate enrollment and 74.9% of the graduate enrollment.

2008 Summary of Part-Time Undergraduate and Graduate Students by Gender

The total enrollment for part-time students in the undergraduate and graduate programs is 561. The *graduate* program accounts for 50.6% of the College of Education's total part-time enrollment. In addition, the female population accounts for 80.3% of the graduate enrollment and 77.6% of the undergraduate graduate enrollment.
