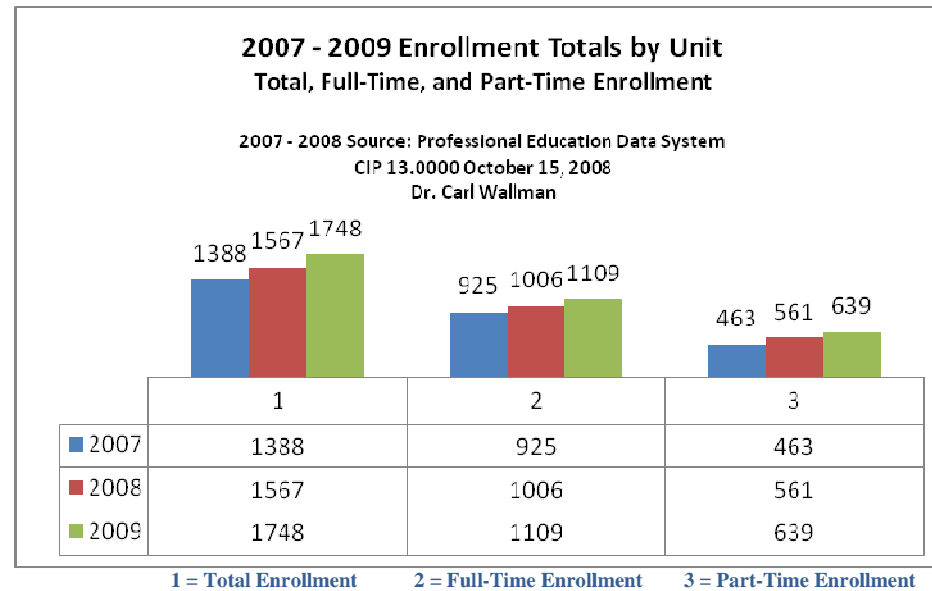

 Enrollment Data 2008



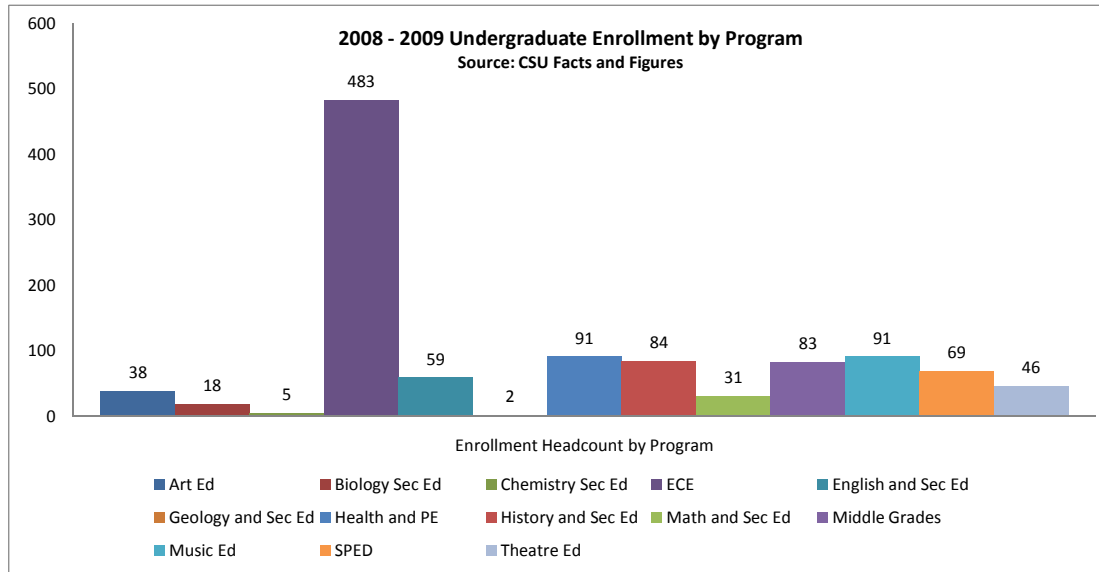

Total Enrollment by Undergraduate Program



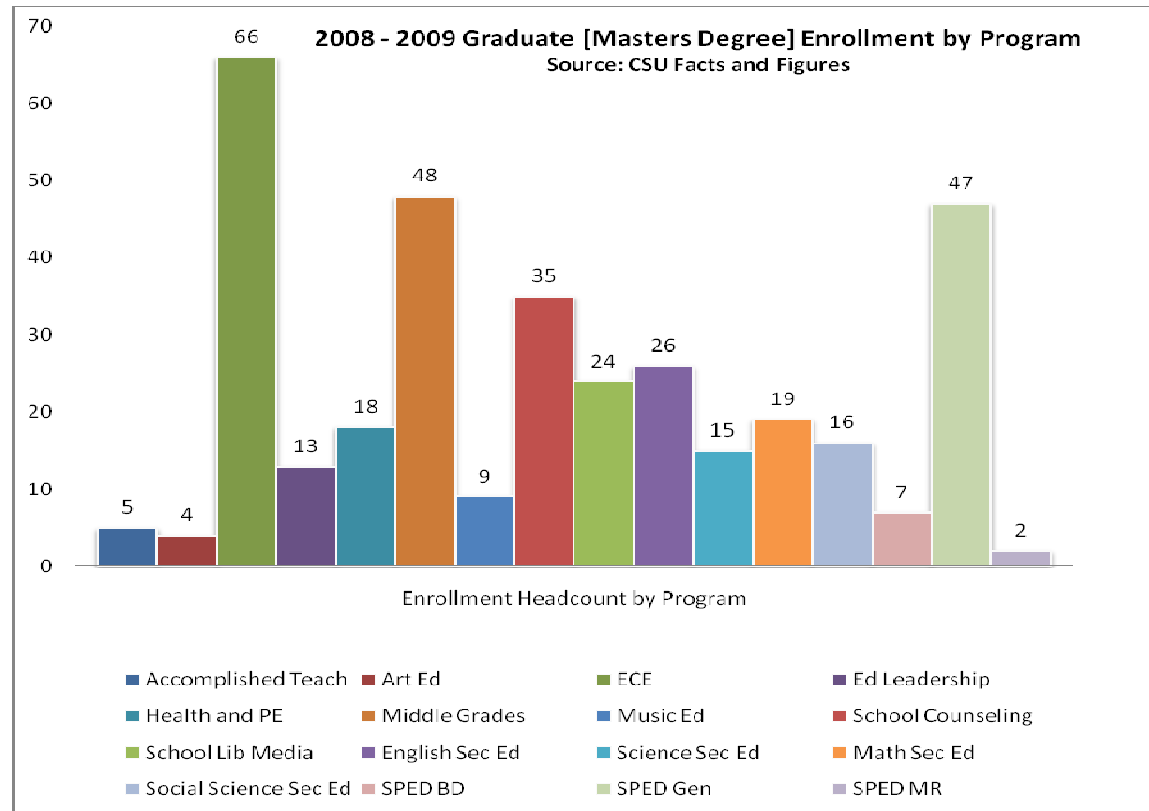

Total Enrollment by Graduate [Masters Degree] Program

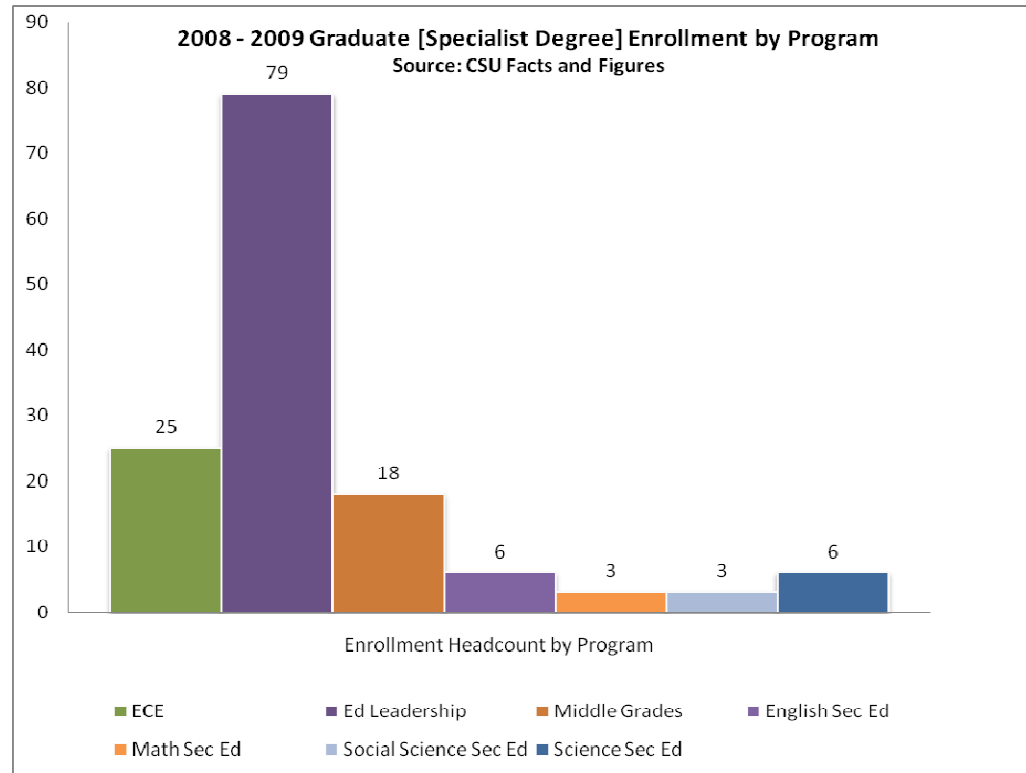


Total graduate [master degree] enrollment by program: 354
